10 3. The Company is an electric public utility in the state of Oregon and is subject to  
11 the jurisdiction of the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission).

12 4. On April 25, 2016, the Northwest and Intermountain Power Producers Coalition  
13 (NIPPC) filed a petition for a temporary rulemaking, docketed as AR 598, and a request to


1 open an investigation into PacifiCorp's 2016 requests for proposal (RFPs) in connection with  
2 renewable energy and renewable energy certificates, docketed as UM 1771. PacifiCorp has a  
3 significant interest in the proceeding, as NIPPC's filing seeks to bar PacifiCorp from  
4 acquiring ownership interests in renewable energy facilities and delay the Company's  
5 recently-issued RFPs. No other party can adequately represent the interests of the Company  
6 in this proceeding.

7 5. The Company has special knowledge or expertise that may assist the Commission  
8 in resolving the issues in the proceeding.

9 6. Based on the information provided above in compliance with the Commission's  
10 rules of procedure, the Company requests to participate in these proceedings with full party  
11 status. The Company's participation in this docket will not unreasonably broaden the issues,  
12 burden the record, or delay the proceeding.

13 The Company therefore respectfully requests that the Commission grant this petition  
14 to intervene.
