Re: UM 1514 Automated Demand Response - Interim Report

In accordance with the timeline PGE established for its Automated Demand Response pilot (ADR or Energy Partner) and the OPUC Staff's request for interim reporting, attached is PGE's interim report for the summer 2016 operating season. PGE's primary goal for the season was to continue to expand program participation, and call demand response events as appropriate. The following is a summary of ADR's seventh operating season:

- PGE called three events during the summer 2016 season.
- As of September 30, 2016, PGE's third-party provider, EnerNOC, had signed contracts from 40 customers representing 74 sites enrolled in the pilot.
- The average nomination for the summer 2016 season was 9.9 MW, which was 18% lower than the 12.2 MW average nomination from the previous winter season. The primary reasons for the reduction are:
 - Many customer nominations were reduced by 10-20% to accommodate changing production schedules;
 - o Personnel changes at a few sites impacted the site's ability to perform to previous levels; and
 - o New customer nominations have been below expected values.
- PGE and EnerNOC continue to expand efforts to enroll customers in the pilot and we estimate the winter 2017 capacity to be approximately 13 MW.
