Dear Mr. Rossow,

Pursuant to OAR 860-029-0080(2), I am filing avoided cost information on behalf of members of the Oregon Municipal Electric Utilities Association (OMEU). A list of the OMEU members and individual contact information is attached.

Under current contracts, OMEU members as public agencies primarily buy their wholesale power requirements from the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) at the Priority Firm (PF) rate in accordance with Section 5(b)(1) of the Northwest Power Act. These purchases are made at Tier 1 rates, the BPA Load Shaping rate, or one of BPA's Tier 2 rates (either at the Load Growth or Short Term rate).

BPA and OMEU member utilities all signed 20-year Load Following contracts that took effect on October 1, 2011 and end on September 30, 2028. These contracts confer the ability to purchase an established amount of power at an embedded cost rate (Tier 1) and a Load Growth or Short Term Tier 2 Rate for publicly owned utilities that contract with BPA to meet their wholesale power needs.

Though some utilities apply limited amounts of non-federal resources to load, currently all OMEU utilities have committed to purchase the remaining balance of their above high water mark (load growth) requirements with BPA purchases at the BPA Load Shaping rate or at one of the take-or-pay BPA Tier 2 rates. The High Water Mark is essentially a set apportionment for each BPA customer of cost based power from the federal system. Avoided costs, or the cost of meeting load growth, will vary by utility depending upon the relationship of the utility's load to their High Water Mark. For those OMEU members whose load is below their High Water Mark, load growth will be met at the Tier 1 rate. The current average Tier 1 rate of 36.34 mills/kWh which remains in effect through September 30, 2021. For those OMEU members whose loads are above their High Water Mark, load growth will be met at an average Tier 2 rate of 31.66 mills/kWh for FY 20-21, which also remains in effect through September 30, 2021. Any load growth

The average Load Shaping rate of 18.95 mills/kWh remains in effect through September 30, 2021. Note that these avoided cost figures reflect energy, capacity, transmission, and ancillary services based on aggregate load profiles.

It is important to note that the BPA FY 2022 and FY 2023 rates will be updated in a rate proceeding that began in early December, but will not be finalized until July of 2021. Those updated BPA rates will succeed the currently filed avoided cost rates.
