Dear Paul:

Hood River Electric Cooperative (HREC) currently purchases all wholesale power required to serve our membership from the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA).

HREC signed a 20-year contract with BPA committing to remain a Load Following customer of BPA through September 2028. Under the contract, HREC has received an allocated share of their BPA system output (our Tier 1 allocation) and has agreed to purchase all of its energy needs from BPA, instead of from other sources, up to the amount of its Tier 1 allocation. If HREC's load exceeds the allocation, HREC may acquire sufficient resources from BPA or another source to cover the additional load. It is our current practice to purchase those additional resources through BPA's Tier 2 product offerings.

Current BPA load forecasts suggest HREC's load can be served using a combination of the Tier 1 allocation, Load Shaping Charge, and BPA's Load Growth or Short-Term Tier 2 products for several years into the future. The following are our best estimates of these costs at this time:

**Load Shaping:** BPA forecasts that HREC will pay a Load Shaping Charge in some months and receive a Load Shaping Credit in others. The Load Shaping Charge for the current BPA rate period ranges from \$10.52 to \$28.09/MWH during Heavy Load Hours and from \$1.68 to \$23.56/MWH during Light Load Hours. The Load Shaping Charge for the next BPA rate period is not established at this time. Early indications suggest it will be similar to the current charge.

**Tier 2 Power:** HREC purchases Tier 2 power from BPA under their Short-Term rate, which is currently \$30.32/MWH. The Short-Term rate for the rate period beginning October 1, 2021, has not been established at this time. Early indications are that the rate will be in the range of \$32.58/MWH.
