The prior year ending balance does not tie out to this years beginning balance. The company reports it's financials as tax basis and requries a conversion to PUC accounting for this report. So there are permanent differences in the retained earnings balance for CIAC transactions, depreciation expense, and state and federal taxes from the companies tax basis general ledger and the theoretical balance for PUC reporting. And it appears that the 2014 annual report that was prepared by an outside accounting firm had an erroneous ending balance that didn't fully consider the correct CIAC balance and ending Plant balances.
