RE: Request for waiver in Solar Pilot Program

On October 1, 2013 I submitted an enrollment application for David Adelsheim to enter the solar pilot program lottery. Mr. Adelsheim was selected in the lottery to participate in the program and paid the \$500 reservation deposit. His confirmation code is J828R3.

On December 18, 2013 Mr. Adelsheim received an email from PGE stating that the estimated annual production (KWH) of the proposed solar system would exceed the property's typical annual usage and that payments from PGE would be made for generation only up to his annual usage. PGE requested a reply stating that he understood the requirement for payment and that he understood that any excess generation above annual usage would not be paid to him. On December 24, 2013 Mr. Adelsheim replied to PGE acknowledging their email and affirming his desire to move forward.

On December 26, 2013 PGE sent Mr. Adelsheim an email stating that he was officially accepted into the pilot program and that his reservation start date was December 18, 2013. Furthermore, the email stated that he had two months to submit an interconnection application to PGE and one year to have his system operational.

I made the mistake of failing to submit the interconnection application to PGE within the two month period and I am requesting a waiver of the resulting expiration of his pilot program reservation. I have never before missed any pilot program deadlines and to be honest, I am surprised and frankly embarrassed to have missed this one.

Mr. Adelsheim had no part in the failure of the interconnection application to be submitted. It is entirely my fault and responsibility. If we are granted the waiver, I can state with 100% certainty that the system will be operational within one year of his reservation start date. I have managed 20 pilot program installations in the past and every one of them was installed well within the 12 month window – in fact, most of them were installed within 4 months of the reservation start date.

Mr. Adelsheim has installed a new roof and is updating his electrical service to accommodate a remodel of his home and the installation of the solar system. The system design is complete, the electrical layout has been created and bill of materials is set. Everything is in place to have his system installed within the one year reservation window.

I would be profoundly grateful if the Commission would grant a waiver for David Adelsheim.
