On March 5, 2014, we contracted with Stelcorenergy to install a 4.91 kW solar array on our house in Tigard.

On April 1, 2014, Stelcorenergy made application on our behalf for the feed in solar program. They also paid the \$500 reservation deposit. The confirmation code is K410V8. Being excited about the program I personally called PGE to see if we were in the program. I was told verbally that we were and that Stelcorenergy would take care of the details.

Unknown to us and PGE, the incorrect email address <u>Linda@Boekleheide.com</u> was in their system. The email address should have been <u>Linda@Boekelheide.com</u>. Because of this we never heard anything from PGE. Stelcorenergy did get the correspondence from PGE.

On April 7, 2014, I electronically signed the PGE forms for our proposed system.

On April 10, 2014, I received confirmation from Stelcorenergy that my application was "signed and filed". I didn't realize that meant filed with Stelcorenergy, not PGE. Through some clerical error Stelcorenergy did not make the filing with PGE.

On June 1, 2014, our application time expired and, without our knowledge, we were dropped from the program.

On June 18, 2014, construction of our system began. A week later it completed with an inspection by the city of Tigard.

On July 2, 2014 I called PGE trying to find out when our system would be turned on. After talking with numerous people I discovered we had been dropped from the program because PGE had never received a filing for us.

I am making this request because I am anxious to be in this program and get our system running. It pains me to see the array up there doing nothing through no fault on our part. I will be very grateful if the commission grants me a waiver.
