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The purpose of this filing is to apply for a three month extension of the deadline for the solar installation at 3763 SE Grant St, Portland, OR 97214. The current completion date requires that the system be online by October 11, 2014. We would like to request that the deadline be extended to January 11, 2015.

On October 1, 2013, Grant Sawyer submitted an enrollment application to enter the solar pilot program lottery. He was selected to participate on October 11, and his confirmation code is J828R3. His \$500 reservation deposit was paid.

On December 4, 2013, Mr. Sawyer signed the PGE Solar Payment Option application and it was mailed to PGE.

On December 5, 2013, Mr. Sawyer submitted an interconnection application and agreement to PGE. The installation of the solar system is contingent on the completion of the roof and electrical system of the accessory dwelling unit on which it will be installed.

Since being approved for the solar pilot program, the homeowner made the decision to build the ADU to meet of both Energy Star Certification and PGE's Earth Advantage Path 4 high efficiency standards. Redesign work and permitting delayed the start of the project by approximately three months. The design was finalized in May and Mr. Sawyer broke ground on the ADU shortly afterward.

During construction, Mr. Sawyer experienced some health issues. He is very involved in the construction of the ADU, so construction was stalled.

As of July 16, the ADU has been framed roughed-in for plumbing, mechanical, and electrical. It will be ready for solar installation when the roof and electrical have

been sufficiently completed. We are confident that solar installation will be completed by January 11, 2015.

The financing for this project is already secured. Mr. Sawyer has money on hand, therefore ensuring the project will indeed be completed as specified if this deadline extension is granted. Mr. Sawyer is very invested in renewable energy, and is excited to see this solar installation through.

Mr. Sawyer is dedicated to incorporating energy efficiency into this project. He is a retired employee of Cowlitz County Public Utility District in Longview, Washington and worked extensively in energy conservation and solar energy during his time there.
