INTRODUCTION 9 Pursuant to OAR 860-001-0400(2) and OAR 860-027-0000(2) Idaho Power 10 Company ("Idaho Power" or "Company") respectfully requests that the Public Utility 11 Commission of Oregon ("Commission") waive certain requirements set forth in OAR 860-12 027-0005, -0015, and -0070 that address the due date for the filing of the Budget of 13 Expenditures report ("Budget of Expenditures"), the New Construction Budget report 14 ("New Construction Budget"), and the annual report ("FERC Form 1"). OAR 860-027-15 0000(2) allows the Commission to "waive any of the Division 027 rules for good cause 16 shown." In this case, requiring compliance with the terms of OAR 860-027-0005, -0015, 17 and -0070(1) is not feasible because data required for the reports is not finalized until after 18 the required due dates. Therefore, Idaho Power is asking the Commission to allow the 19 Company to file its 2014 Budget of Expenditures and the 2014 New Construction Budget 20 by March 15, 2014, and to file the FERC Form 1 for the calendar year 2013 by May 1, 21 2014. 22 Communications regarding this Application should be addressed to: 23 Lisa D. 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II. BACKGROUND

OAR 860-027-0005 and 860-027-0015 require the annual filing of budget reports. OAR 860-027-0005 states that "Each energy utility operating within Oregon and having gross operating revenues of \$50,000 or more per annum is required to file with the Commission on or before the first day of November of each year, a copy of its proposed Budget of Expenditures, on forms approved by the Commission" while OAR 860-027-0015 establishes a December 31 filing date for the New Construction Budget stating, "Each energy utility operating within Oregon is required to file annually on or before December 31 on forms approved by the Commission information on new construction, extensions, and additions to the utility's property." Both the Budget of Expenditures and New Construction Budget are based on the Company's annual capital budget that is approved by the Board of Directors during its mid-January meeting of the budget year. Idaho Power has routinely asked the Commission for, and has been granted, an extension of these reporting deadlines to March 15 of the budget year.

OAR 860-027-0070(1), the annual report requirements for electric utilities, provides that "Annual Reports will be submitted by electric, gas, water, and steam heat utilities. The report shall be submitted on or before April 1, using the most current forms approved by the Commission." Similar to the budget reports, financial data used to complete the FERC Form 1 is not available in time to complete the report by April 1. Idaho Power has routinely asked for, and has been granted, an extension of the April 1 filing date to May 1 of the same year.

On October 16, 2013, Commission Staff contacted the Company indicating that the Commission may grant a waiver of the rule setting the due date for budget and annual reports and directed Idaho Power to apply for a waiver of OAR 860-027-0005, -0015, and -0070 as provided for in OAR 860-027-0000(2).

III. DISCUSSION

6 A. <u>It is Not Feasible for Idaho Power to Complete the Budget and Annual Reports by the Due Dates.</u>

Idaho Power's budget process begins during the fall prior to the budget year. Signoff on the budget is vested in the Board of Directors of IDACORP, Inc. ("IDACORP"), a holding company whose principal operating subsidiary is Idaho Power, and the highest decision making body of the Company. IDACORP has a set of established guidelines that describe the budget-related matters that the Board must approve, including both the Capital Budget and the Operation and Maintenance Budget. The budgets are presented to the Board of Directors during the January meeting of the budget year. On occasion, budget approval has been deferred until late February of the budget year. As soon as the budgets are approved, the Company can begin preparation of the Budget of Expenditures and New Construction Budget. Without an internally approved budget, Idaho Power cannot meet its obligation under OAR 860-027-0005 and 860-027-0015. Once compiled, the budget reports are reviewed, the Budget of Expenditures is signed by officers of the Company as required, and the reports are filed with the Commission, months after the November 1 filing requirement.

Similarly, the preparation of the FERC Form 1 cannot begin until the Company can obtain its finalized and audited year-end financial data. When the financial data is available, Idaho Power begins preparation of the FERC Form 1 as required by OAR 860-027-0070(1). The FERC Form 1 is not completed and filed with the Federal Energy

1	Regulatory Commission until April 15 of each year, after the April 1 filing requirement of		
2	OAR 860-027-0070.		
3	B. Idaho Power Has Historically Received an Extension of the Filing Date for the Budget and Annual Reports.		
5	Idaho Power's budget and reporting of financial data practices are not new; like most		
6	utilities, the Company has repeatedly requested extensions of the filing dates based on		
7	internal processes that produce the data required for the reports. In recent years,		
8	Commission Staff has accepted the Company's informal requests for an extension of the		
9	filing date for all three reports. As it has committed in the past, if a waiver of OAR 860-		
10	027-0005, -0015, and -0070(1) is granted, Idaho Power will make every attempt to file the		
11	reports prior to the extension dates requested.		
12	IV. CONCLUSION		
13	Idaho Power respectfully requests that the Commission waive the requirement in		
14	OAR 860-027-0005, -0015, and -0070(1) that address the due date for the filing of the		
15	Budget of Expenditures, the New Construction Budget, and the FERC Form 1 and allow		
16	the Company to file its 2014 Budget of Expenditures and 2014 New Construction Budget		
17	by March 15, 2014, and to file its FERC Form 1 for the calendar year 2013 by May 1,		
18	2014.
