Re: UM 1636(7) - Request for Deferral Accounting for the Cost of Expenses for Manufactured Gas Plant in Eugene

Cascade Natural Gas Corporation (Cascade or the Company) submits the attached Application for an accounting order for reauthorization to record and defer environmental remediation work at the Manufactured Gas Plant (MGP) in Eugene, Oregon.

As of September 30, 2018, the due date used in the current deferral application, the current deferral balance is \$316,813.47. This amount includes preliminary investigation costs, outside legal costs, interest, etc., and is net of insurance proceeds. Cascade expects to begin and complete actual remediation costs in 2019 at an anticipated cost of \$1.7 million.

Total expected deferral balance at the end of 2019 is anticipated to be the beginning balance of \$316,813.47, plus estimated remediation costs of \$1,700,000, plus interest on the balance, plus any residual preliminary investigation costs, less any potential insurance proceeds. At this point the total estimated deferral balance at the end of 2019 will be approximately \$2,100,000. Cascade anticipates, beyond the completion of the remediation efforts, that only ongoing testing and monitoring costs plus outside legal costs to pursue insurance recovery will be included in the deferral balance.

12	expenses for environmental remediation work at the Manufactured Gas Plant (MGP) in Eugene, Oregon.					
13	The Company respectfully requests that the 12- month deferral period commence December 1, 2018,					
14	and end November 30, 2019.
