Removes package change fee from the residential STAR Packages

I have reviewed this filing and recommend that an acknowledgement letter be sent. The filing went into effect on May 5, 2017, and was filed on May 4, 2017. The company proposes to remove a non-recurring charge when a customer changes between its STAR packages.

The removal of the change charge leaves the recurring rates and conditions of service unchanged.

The filing complies with Oregon Revised Statute (ORS) 759.175, which requires telecommunications utilities to submit tariff filings to the Commission whenever a telecommunications utility intends to change its rates, terms, or conditions of service. Under ORS 759.040, the company can make tariff filings effective upon notice to the Commission.

This filing meets the requirements of the applicable Commission rules and Oregon statutes.

This filing would have minimal effect on annual revenues.
