SUBJECT: FRONTIER COMMUNICATIONS NORTHWEST INC: (Advice No. 1037)
Establishes Foreign Exchange Listing and Extra Lines of Information as
directory listing services.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the tariff sheets filed be allowed to go into effect.

DISCUSSION:

Frontier Communications Northwest Inc. (Frontier) proposes to introduce Foreign Exchange Listing and Extra Lines of Information directory services. The proposed monthly rate for both services is \$1.50.

Foreign Exchange Listing is a listing appearing in a directory other than the directory in which local exchange service is furnished or associated with a service provider that does not have a directory listing agreement in place. Extra Lines of Information is descriptive information in addition to a primary or extra listing that is intended to supply additional or special instructions to calling parties, such as office hours.

The filing was submitted on April 16, 2014, and thus complies with Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 759.190, which requires tariff filings to be made at least thirty days prior to their effective dates. Telecommunications utilities are required under ORS 759.175 to submit tariff filings to the Commission whenever they intend to change their rates, terms, or conditions of service.

Frontier submitted an analysis showing that the proposed rates cover the long-run incremental cost (LRIC) of the service. The company estimates that this filing will have a negligible impact on annual revenues.
