SUBJECT: Asotin Telephone Company, Advice No. 110

Removes the Total Talk Pack bundle from the tariff.

I have reviewed this filing and recommend that an acknowledgement letter be sent. The filing went into effect on December 19, 2014, and was filed on December 18, 2014. The company proposes to remove the Total Talk Pack bundle from the tariff. This bundle is grandfathered and currently has no customers subscribing to it.

Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 860-032-0020 (8) permits a telecommunications utility to abandon a regulated service for which there are no current customers by filing a tariff change which deletes the regulated service. The filing must clearly and explicitly disclose which regulated service the utility proposes to abandon.

The filing complies with Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 759.175, which requires telecommunications utilities to submit tariff filings to the Commission whenever a telecommunications utility intends to change its rates, terms, or conditions of service. Under ORS 759.040, the company can make tariff filings effective upon notice to the Commission.

I find that this filing meets the requirements of the Commission's rules and Oregon statutes.

This filing would have no effect on annual revenues.
