to Talking Call Waiting.

I have reviewed this filing and recommend that an acknowledgement letter be sent. The filing went into effect on December 22, 2014, and was filed on December 18, 2014. The company proposes to make text changes to certain feature packages in its Price List to remove obsolete references to the Talking Call Waiting feature.

The filing complies with Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 759.175, which requires telecommunications utilities to submit tariff filings to the Commission whenever a telecommunications utility intends to change its rates, terms, or conditions of service. Under ORS 759.054, price list filings can become effective upon filing with the Commission.

The Talking Call Waiting feature was deleted from the company's price list in compliance with Order No. 12-005 in Docket No. UM 1560, which concerned a petition for abandonment of service. The compliance filing was Advice No. OR11-15, which was effective February 1, 2012.

This filing would not affect annual revenues.
