Revises the Construction Charges tariff to include Relocation or  
Rearrangement of Facilities.

I have reviewed this filing and recommend that an acknowledgement letter be sent. The filing went into effect on October 10, 2014, and was filed on October 9, 2014. The company proposes to revise the Construction Charges tariff. The revisions include moving and combining Relocation or Rearrangement of Facilities in Section III with the Construction Charges in Section VII. Additionally, several specific topics are being removed from the Construction Charges tariff and replaced with more universal language. The revised tariff applies to requests for basic local exchange service. Other requests for basic local service will be provided under individual contracts.

The company states that this revision is being made "to meet current marketing conditions, new technologies, and standardize language between all TDS ILEC companies."

This filing will have a negligible revenue effect.
