Establishes the gross revenue fee level for telecommunications providers

for 2015.

## STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

By November 1, 2014, the Commission issue an order to set the annual PUC fee at 0.25 percent as the percentage rate for annual fees due from telecommunications providers on April 1, 2016, in accordance with ORS 756.310.

## **DISCUSSION:**

ORS 756.310(6) requires each telecommunications provider<sup>1</sup> to pay up to 25 hundredths of one percent (0.25 percent) of its gross retail intrastate Oregon revenue or \$100, whichever is more, to the Commission. The Commission opened Docket No. UM 940 in 1999 to set the annual fee levels for telecommunications providers, and the annual rates have been set at the statutory maximum of 0.25 percent.

The Commission collected \$1.19 million in annual fees from telecommunications providers in 2012, \$1.86 million in 2013, and approximately \$1.71 million in 2014.<sup>2</sup>

This definition excludes radio common carriers and telecommunications cooperatives with certificates issued only under ORS 759.025.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> The reason for the dramatic increase in revenues between 2012 and 2013 was the rate increase. In 2011 and 2012, the rate was lowered to bring the average balance down. In 2013, the rate was returned to .25 percent.

During this three-year period, intrastate retail revenues declined by 16.1 percent. Staff is forecasting continuing declines in Oregon gross retail intrastate revenues due to continuing line losses. Therefore, for revenues recorded in 2014, the Commission should continue to assess the annual fee at the statutory maximum level of .25 percent. I estimate this assessment rate will provide annual fees of \$1.42 million from telecommunications providers for 2015.

The Commission must issue an order to establish the percentage rate for the annual fee "not less than 60 days prior to the calendar year upon which the fee is based" (ORS 756.310(6)(a)). For revenues recorded during 2015, this provision means the fee level order must be issued by November 1, 2014.

## PROPOSED COMMISSION MOTION:

The annual gross revenue fee for telecommunications providers be set at the maximum level of 0.25 percent for calendar year 2015.
