SUBJECT: Acknowledgement of Pelican Bay Heights Water System, LLC.'s
Compliance Filing in accordance to Order No.18-122, Docket No. UP 356.

BACKGROUND

Pelican Bay Heights Water System, LLC. (Pelican Bay) has completed its annexation of the Pelican Bay water system into the Harbor Water District, P.U.D. (Harbor Water).

In accordance to Condition No. 2 of Order No. 18-122, in Docket No. UP 356, Pelican Bay has notified the Commission of the completion of the annexation by filing a copy of Harbor Water's meeting minutes voting for approval of the annexation agreement. No substantive changes were mentioned in the meeting minutes in accordance to Condition No. 1 of Order No. 18-122.

Conclusions

Staff has investigated the filing and finds that all conditions in Order No. 18-122, Docket No. UP 356 are met. As the Commission does not regulate P.U.D's, this annexation removes Commission regulation from Pelican Bay. Pelican Bay's plant assets and customers have been successfully transferred to Harbor Water. With the completion of this transfer, Pelican Bay no longer exists and has been removed from Commission records.

Staff recommends a letter of acknowledgement be sent to acknowledge the completion of the annexation to Harbor Water and to advise that as all conditions of Order No. 18-122 have been satisfied, the Commission removes regulation.
