DISPOSITION: MOTION GRANTED; ORAL ARGUMENT SCHEDULED


Georgia-Pacific Consumers Product (Camas) LLC and Clatskanie People's Utility District (petitioners) request oral argument on the applicability of Oregon's territory allocation and direct access laws to a proposed electric service arrangement.¹

The motion is granted. The Commission will hold oral arguments in this matter on August 19, 2015, at 1:30 p.m. The parties will have the opportunity to present argument, during which the Commissioners and I may ask questions.
