**NOTICE AND RULING**

**DISPOSITION: COMPLAINANT TO STATE INTENTION TO PURSUE  
CLAIMS OR HAVE COMPLAINT DISMISSED**

In response to my notice and ruling of February 9, 2017, North County filed a status report and proposed procedural schedule on February 28, 2017, indicating the complainant's intention to file a motion for summary judgment on June 2, 2017.


On March 29, 2017, Dale Dixon, Jr. withdrew as counsel of record in this case. No mention of the proposed procedural schedule was made in the motion to withdraw, and no pleadings have been filed with the Commission in accordance with the proposed procedural schedule.

The Commission therefore concludes that the complainant should be given one final opportunity to set forth its intentions with particularity in order to avoid dismissal of its complaint for failure to prosecute.

**RULING**

The complainant shall notify the Commission of its intention to prosecute its claims and propose a procedural schedule no later than June 30, 2017. If complainant fails to comply with this ruling, the complaint of North County Communications Corporation of Oregon against Qwest Corporation d/b/a CenturyLink QC shall be subject to dismissal with prejudice.
