RULING

DISPOSITION: MOTION GRANTED: SCHEDULE SUSPENDED

On December 5, 2012, North County Communications Corporation of Oregon and Qwest Corporation d/b/a CenturyLink QC filed a joint motion to suspend the procedural schedule in this docket. In their motion, the parties state that the case is currently before the Arizona Commission and the parties would like to proceed with the case there first. Once the procedural schedule has been set in Arizona, the parties propose a revised schedule be adopted for the proceedings in Oregon.

I find that good cause has been shown to suspend the procedural schedule and, at this time, it does not appear that a brief suspension will unduly delay the proceedings. However, the parties are directed to provide, on or before Friday, February 1, 2013, an update of the status of the proceedings in Arizona and a tentative date upon which they will propose a new procedural schedule for the proceedings in Oregon.
