DISPOSITION: MOTION GRANTED; PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE MODIFIED

On November 9, 2018, the Commission reopened this proceeding to receive additional testimony from TPUD. Dates were set for the submission of testimony by TPUD, reply testimony by Staff and Intervenors, and rebuttal testimony by the utility. The briefing schedule was vacated.

By motion filed December 7, 2018, TPUD requests that the schedule be modified. Under the original schedule, its testimony was due to be submitted on December 10, 2018. Given the extent of the testimony required, TPUD states that it needs additional time to complete its preparation. The utility asks that the date be extended to December 14, 2018.

TPUD notes that the original date set for reply testimony (December 26, 2018) falls between two national holidays and causes hardship. The utility proposes that the date be extended to January 16, 2019.

In its motion, TPUD does not address the date for filing its rebuttal testimony. In the original schedule that date was set for ten days after the date for filing reply testimony.

TPUD has not been able to confer with other parties, except for Staff, due to the shortness of time (and the number of parties). TPUD states that Staff supports its motion.

For good cause shown, I grant TPUD's motion, with a slight amendment. The date for TPUD's filing of its initial testimony is set for December 17, 2018. The date for Staff and Intervenor reply testimony is set for January 16, 2019. The date for TPUD's rebuttal testimony is set for January 28, 2019.
