**DISPOSITION: SCHEDULE MODIFIED**

On April 14, 2005, PacifiCorp filed a motion to amend the procedural schedule in this proceeding (Motion). PacifiCorp recommends that modifications to the existing schedule are needed to facilitate further settlement discussions, as follows:

Staff and Intervenors file Direct Testimony	May 5, 2005	May 9, 2005
PacifiCorp files Rebuttal Testimony	May 31, 2005	June 2, 2005
Staff and Intervenors file Surrebuttal Testimony	June 21, 2005	June 22, 2005

PacifiCorp indicates that parties participating in settlement discussions to date support the Motion, including: Staff, the Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon, the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities and Fred Meyer Stores and Quality Food Centers. PacifiCorp did not indicate whether other parties had been contacted about the proposed schedule change.

I find good cause to modify the procedural schedule in this docket in order to facilitate further settlement discussions. Consequently, the schedule is tentatively modified as indicated above.<sup>1</sup> Any party objecting to the schedule change should reply to the Motion on an expedited basis by the close of business on April 20, 2005. Should no objections be received by that time, the schedule will be finally modified.
