Also on July 29, PacifiCorp file stipulation, PacifiCorp agreed to "waive the cu		rth Partial Stipulation. Within the bension date of September 12, 20

Also on July 29, PacifiCorp filed the Fourth Partial Stipulation. Within that stipulation, PacifiCorp agreed to "waive the current suspension date of September 12, 2005 to October 4, 2005." Fourth Partial Stipulation at 6. Since the waiver of the suspension period is contained in the stipulation, the waiver cannot take effect unless the Commission adopts the stipulation in a final order entered prior to September 12. This creates an issue of timing if the order were to be entered after September 12. To eliminate this confusion, PacifiCorp is to submit a letter to the Commission indicating that it is amenable to extending the current suspension date to October 4, 2005.

Finally, all parties have filed the requisite witness affidavits with the Commission. The testimony in support of the stipulation should be filed no later than August 11, 2005. Once that testimony is filed, the evidentiary record will be closed.
