On March 15, 2006, the Commission will hear oral argument in this proceeding. The following parties, listed in order of presentation, will appear:

- PacifiCorp
- Klamath Water Users Association (KWUA)
- Klamath Off-Project Water Users (KOPWU)
- Bureau of Reclamation
- WaterWatch
- Commission Staff (Staff)

As previously noted, the oral arguments are scheduled to begin at 9:30 a.m. in the Commission’s Main Hearing Room in Salem, Oregon. Each party will have ten minutes to present its argument. As the party with the burden of persuasion, PacifiCorp will also have an additional five minutes for rebuttal.

In addition to other issues previously identified in this matter, the parties should address the relationship between this Commission’s authority to set retail rates for PacifiCorp’s irrigation customers and the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission’s (FERC) authority to establish Government dam use charges and determine and assess headwater benefits for the Klamath Hydroelectric Project. No. 2082.
