**DISPOSITION: CROSS-EXAMINATION SCHEDULE SET**

On April 14, 2006, Staff, PacifiCorp, Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities (ICNU) and Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon (CUB) filed cross-examination statements. Only PacifiCorp and ICNU wish to cross-examine witnesses.

I have set the schedule so that PacifiCorp's testimony & exhibits will have been entered into the record prior to Mr. Selecky's testimony. While ICNU requested to have Mr. Selecky cross-examined first due to his flight schedule, the abbreviated hearing schedule should allow Mr. Selecky to easily catch an afternoon flight. The order of cross-examination is follows:

Witness affidavits for witnesses not being cross-examined must be filed before 9:00 a.m. on April 19, 2006. Finally, I have not had a request for oral argument in this docket. Unless I hear otherwise by the beginning of hearing, oral argument will not be set.
