The schedule in this docket required staff and intervenors to file testimony by May 9, 2005. On that date, Klamath Water Users Association (KWUA) submitted a letter in lieu of opening testimony, asking to reserve its ability to file its testimony after the resolution of legal issues in docket UE 171. On May 12, 2005, I issued a letter opinion informing KWUA that if it wished to file opening testimony, it must file its testimony along with a motion out of time by May 19, 2005. Further, KWUA was told that if it chose to not file testimony in this docket, KWUA was jeopardizing its ability to receive intervenor funding.
On May 19, 2005, KWUA filed an out of time motion and testimony. Parties have until May 26, 2005, to object to KWUA's motion. If no objections are filed, the testimony will be considered to be timely prefiled. As usual, a determination of whether the testimony is admissible will be made later in the proceeding.
