DISPOSITION: DATE ESTABLISHED FOR MOTION RESPONSES

On March 27, 2006, the Klamath Water Users Association (KWUA) moved to reopen the record, asking that a document filed by PacifiCorp in a FERC proceeding be made part of the UE 170 evidentiary record. In the alternative, KWUA asks that official notice be taken of the document.

Parties have 15 days to respond to a motion, unless otherwise specified by the Administrative Law Judge. OAR 860-013-0050(3)(d). Because a Commission order is due by mid-April, I am modifying the amount of time for filing responses. Any parties who choose to respond to the motion must do so by **4:00 pm on March 31, 2006**.

Responses to the motion are not arguments about the substance of the material that KWUA wishes to enter into the record. Rather, responses are to be limited to whether the docket should be reopened to admit the requested document, or whether official notice should be taken of the document.
