2013 Annual Power Cost Variance Mechanism

DISPOSITION: REQUEST TO DESIGNATE AVAILABILITY OF TESTIMONY FROM GENERAL RATE CASE GRANTED

In this ruling, we designate all of the testimony filed by Portland General Electric Company on February 13, 2014 in docket UE 283,¹ as available in this docket.

On March 11, 2014, I issued a prehearing conference memorandum and ruling bifurcating docket UE 283 (the company's general rate case) so that net variable power cost (NVPC) and annual power cost update (APCU) issues could be addressed on a separate timetable, and directing the parties to designate portions of PGE's direct testimony to be included in this docket.

On April 18, 2014, counsel for the Commission Staff, with the concurrence of the other active parties in the docket filed a letter requesting that the entire February 13, 2014 PGE filing in docket UE 283 be made available in this docket.

I find the request reasonable and it is granted.
