Net Variable Power Costs (NVPC) and Annual Power Cost Update (APCU).

DISPOSITION: SCHEDULE SUSPENDED

On July 29, 2014, Portland General Electric Company (PGE) filed a Motion to Suspend Procedural Schedule and requested that the motion be given expedited consideration. In support of the motion, PGE notes that the Commission Staff, the Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon, and the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities (the Stipulating Parties) filed a stipulation in this docket on July 22, 2014, settling all but three issues.

PGE further states that the Stipulating Parties met on July 28, 2014, and settled the remaining issues. PGE represents that a stipulation reflecting that settlement, as well as joint testimony in support of the stipulation, is currently being drafted and will be filed with the Commission shortly.

RULING

I find that good cause has been shown to grant the motion. The motion is granted and the procedural schedule in this docket is temporarily suspended pending receipt of the stipulation and joint testimony.
