DISPOSITION: DATE SPECIFIED FOR NOTIFICATION OF WITNESSES TO BE MADE AVAILABLE FOR CROSS-EXAMINTION; PREHEARING PROCEDURES ADOPTED

A telephone prehearing conference was held in this docket on July 23, 2014. Counsel appeared on behalf of Portland General Electric Company, the Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon, Noble Americas Energy Solutions, the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities and the Staff of the Oregon Public Utility Commission.

At the conference it was agreed that on or before July 30, 2014, the parties shall notify each other of their intention to call opposing witnesses for cross-examination and shall specify the portions of the witnesses' direct testimony that shall be the subject of the cross-examination. The parties further agreed to allow prefiled testimony supported by affidavit to be admitted into the record rather than by sponsorship of a witness present at hearing, if there were no objections by opposing counsel or the Commission Staff. Parties also waived the right to file prehearing briefs.
