On June 24, 2016, Commission Staff filed a motion to amend the procedural schedule in this docket. Staff requests two additional rounds of testimony to more fully develop the record and respond to issues in this proceeding. Staff states that the Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon, the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities, and Noble Solutions support the motion, but that PacifiCorp opposes it. Staff asks for expedited consideration with a ruling issued by Friday, July 1, 2016.

In light of the expedited nature of this request, I find good cause to shorten the deadline for response. The seven-day time period to respond to a procedural motion under OAR 860-001-0420(4) is shortened to five days. Any objection to Staff's motion must be filed on or before Wednesday, June 29, 2016.
