MEMORANDUM AND RULING

DISPOSITION:

HEARING PROCEDURES ADOPTED

The hearing to be held on September 21, 2016 shall be limited to testimony on issues related to Portland General Electric Company's proposed long term gas hedging strategy and shall be organized as follows:

- The hearing shall begin with the swearing in of each witness and the offering of prefiled testimony into the record by counsel.
- 5-10 minute presentations by each witness will follow. Witnesses for each party may appear as individuals or as a panel. Each presentation shall consist of an overview and summary of pre-filed testimony. The overview/summary need not be accompanied by handouts or PowerPoint presentations and should not contain evidence beyond the material previously offered into the record.
- During and after each presentation, the Commissioners and administrative law judges
 will have the opportunity to ask questions of each witness. If a response requires
 information not previously offered into the record, the witness will so indicate and
 other parties shall have the opportunity to examine the witness with respect to such
 new information.
- The order of presentation shall be as follows:
 - o PGE
 - o Commission Staff
 - o Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon
 - Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities

All questions relating to matters of law shall be addressed in post-hearing briefs and, if necessary, oral argument.
