DISPOSITION: RESPONSES TO MOTION TO CANCEL HEARING AND MODIFY

BRIEFING SCHEDULE DUE BY SEPTEMBER 12, 2017; MOTION

GRANTED PENDING NO OBJECTIONS

On September 11, 2017, Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Oregon filed a motion asking the Commission to cancel the hearing scheduled for September 15, 2017. Staff asks that the Commission limit the period for filing responses to the motion to 24 hours.

Staff indicates that it conferred with the other parties that filed testimony, including: Portland General Electric Company; the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities; the Oregon Citizens' Utility Board; Fred Meyer Stores; and Walmart, and all expressly agree to waive cross-examination. Staff states that it notified all parties to the proceeding and no party has objected. Staff concludes that there is no reason to hold the hearing, unless the Commission wishes to examine witnesses, and asks that the hearing be cancelled on an expedited basis.

The motion also requests modifications to the procedural schedule to allow for two rounds of simultaneous briefs, instead of serial briefing:
