DISPOSITION: MOTION GRANTED; PROCEDURDAL SCHEDULE SUSPENDED

On September 27, 2017, Portland General Electric Company (PGE) filed a motion to suspend the procedural schedule. PGE requests expedited consideration because simultaneous opening briefs are due September 29, 2017.

PGE indicates the parties have reached agreement in principle on resolution of the one remaining issue in this docket. The parties anticipate filing a stipulation regarding this remaining issue by October 6, 2017. PGE believes that all parties that participated in settlement discussions will join the stipulation, or not oppose it. PGE adds that it is not aware of any party to this docket who will oppose the stipulation.

PGE reports that Commission Staff, the Oregon Citizens' Utility Board, the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities, and Fred Meyer Stores and Quality Food Centers, a Division of The Kroger Co., support this motion.

For good cause shown, the motion is granted. The remaining procedural schedule is suspended. Upon review of the stipulation, the Commissioners will determine if any further proceedings are required.
