RULING

DISPOSITION: EXTENSION GRANTED THROUGH OCTOBER 31, 2024

On April 30, 2024, Portland General Electric (PGE) filed a motion for extension of time to file its proposed tariff changes for new large load connections, currently due May 1, 2024. PGE states that it has come to an understanding with Commission Staff regarding PGE actions and expectations in developing a proposal in this docket, including the scheduling of a workshop. I note that unless otherwise requested by the parties, I consider this proposed workshop to be Staff led, not a Commission workshop.

PGE communicated that it would seek relief to the Alliance of Western Energy Consumers (AWEC), and the Oregon Citizens' Utility Board (CUB). The company represents that AWEC does not oppose the motion and that CUB has not responded.

Given the detailed understandings outlined in PGE's request, reflecting consensus on process between Staff and PGE, I grant the motion on an expedited basis. The deadline to file the proposed tariffs is changed from May 1, 2024 to October 31, 2024.
