**DISPOSITION: DATE EXTENDED FOR FILING OPENING COMMENTS**

By motion filed May 6, 2011, the Oregon Department of Energy (ODOE) requests that the date for filing opening comments be extended from May 6, 2011, to May 13, 2011. As grounds for its motion ODOE states that its staff has not completed the comments, "and requires an additional week in which to do so."


ODOE requests expedited consideration of its motion.

According to ODOE, representatives of the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Oregon, Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities, Northwest Energy Systems Company, Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon, and Community Renewable Energy Association each indicated support for its motion. Portland General Electric Company, Idaho Power Company and Renewable Energy Coalition each indicated that it did not oppose the motion.

No party indicated that it opposes the motion.

For good cause shown, ODOE's motion is granted. The date for filing opening comments is extended to May 13, 2011.
