DISPOSITION: MOTIONS GRANTED; BRIEFING DATES TO BE SET


All active parties to this docket having advised the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission) that no cross-examination of any witness was planned, by Notice dated June 2, 2009, the Commission canceled the hearing set in this matter. Parties were invited to proffer their testimony and exhibits by motion.

Motions to admit testimony and exhibits, together with supporting witness Affidavits, were received from Commission Staff (Staff/100-101, 102, and 300/Durrenberger); Portland General Electric Company (PGE/100-103 and 200/Kuns and Drennan); PacifiCorp, dba Pacific Power (Pacific Power) (PPL/100 and 101/Warnken); and from the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities (ICNU/100-101, and 200-201/Falkenberg). ICNU filed a motion on June 4, 2009, to supplement the record with its Exhibit 300. On June 8, 2009, Pacific Power filed a motion to admit additional exhibits identified as Exhibit PPL/102.

Each of these motions is granted conditionally, subject to the timely filing of an objection.

The parties are directed to confer and to present the Commission with their proposed schedule for the filing of briefs not later than June 12, 2009.
