
RULING

**DISPOSITION: PETITIONS TO INTERVENE GRANTED**

On July 15, 2010, Nissan North America, Inc. (Nissan) filed a petition to intervene in this proceeding. Nissan has sufficient interest in the proceeding, and its appearance and participation will not unreasonably broaden the issues, burden the record, or unreasonably delay the proceeding. *See* OAR 860-012-0001. Nissan's petition is granted.
