RULING

DISPOSITION: MOTION TO ADMIT *PRO HAC VICE* GRANTED

On February 9, 2011, i-wireless, LLC, filed a Motion to Admit Lance J. M. Steinhart to Appear as Counsel *Pro Hac Vice* in this proceeding. That motion was granted on February 10, 2011. OAR 860-001-0320(3) provides that "Each application is good for one attorney for a single case for one year."

Accordingly, on December 12, 2012, i-wireless, LLC, filed a Motion to Admit Lance J. M. Steinhart *Pro Hac Vice* in this proceeding, so that he could continue to participate as counsel. The Affidavit of Lance J.M. Steinhart accompanies the Motion. Mr. Steinhart states that he will associate with Mark P. Trincherro and Alan Galloway, active members in good standing with the Oregon State Bar.


I have reviewed the Motion to Admit Counsel *Pro Hac Vice* and find that it complies with the requirements of UTCR 3.170 and OAR 860-001-0320.

The period for any party to oppose a *pro hac vice* motion is 7 days after service. *See* OAR 860-001-0420(5).

RULING

The Motion to Admit Counsel *Pro Hac Vice* in this proceeding is conditionally granted and shall be considered final should no party oppose the motion as of December 20, 2012.
