DISPOSITION: DOCKET UM 1535 RENAMED; DOCKET UM 1534 CLOSED

On March 22, 2011, Portland General Electric Company (PGE) filed requests for the Commission to open these two dockets to address the company's requests for proposals (RFPs) to acquire new energy and capacity resources. In Order No. 11-371, the Commission issued a decision on the merits of PGE's request to acquire new capacity resources in docket UM 1535. In that decision the Commission ordered PGE to combine its capacity and energy RFPs into a single filing.

By letter dated January 5, 2012, PGE gave notice that it has issued a combined RFP in docket UM 1535 and makes three requests. First, PGE asks that the Commission change the caption in this docket to reflect the substance of its new filing. Specifically, PGE proposes that this proceeding be titled: Request for Proposals for Capacity and Baseload Energy Resources." Second, given the broader scope of this proceeding, PGE further requests that docket UM 1534 be closed. Finally, as a procedural matter, PGE also asks for confirmation that the protective order issued in docket UM 1535 remains in effect and is applicable to the newly titled proceeding.

PGE's requests are in the nature of housekeeping matters. The request to change the caption in docket UM 1535 to reflect the broader scope of the proceeding is granted. Given that docket UM 1535 now encompasses PGE's requests for both capacity and energy resources, docket UM 1534 is closed. This ruling shall close docket UM 1534 with no further Commission order. Parties are advised that the protective order issued in docket UM 1535 (Order No. 11-097) remains in effect and is applicable to the newly titled proceeding, which will retain the docket number UM 1535.
