MEMORANDUM

Request for Proposals for Capacity Resources.

On August 5, 2013, Grays Harbor Energy, LLC (Grays Harbor), filed a request for an investigation into matters related to Portland General Electric Company's (PGE) 2012 Capacity and Baseload Energy Resources Request for Proposals (RFP). Grays Harbor contends an investigation is needed to determine whether PGE failed to adhere to the Commission's RFP guidelines or engaged in misconduct during the RFP process.

This memorandum provides notice that the Commission will address Grays Harbor's request at the September 19, 2013 Special Public Meeting currently scheduled to consider a petition for declaratory ruling that also concerns PGE's RFP. In that petition, docketed as DR 46, Troutdale Energy Center, LLC, seeks a declaratory ruling with respect to PGE's ability to recover the costs of resources selected during the recent RFP.

PGE may file an answer to Grays Harbor's request by August 23, 2013. To help inform Staff's recommendation to the Commission, other persons intending to file comments to Grays Harbor's petition are requested to do so by August 29, 2013. Staff intends to consider all comments filed in preparing its report and recommendation as to what action the Commission should take in response to Grays Harbor's request.
