RULING

DISPOSITION: MOTION GRANTED; LATE-FILED COMMENTS ACCEPTED

On November 17, 2017, the Oregon Department of Energy (ODOE) filed a motion requesting that the Commission accept ODOE's late-filed comments in this proceeding. In support of its motion, ODOE represents that the filing of comments, which were due to be filed November 16, 2017, was delayed by one day due to unforeseen circumstances. ODOE states that it has notified other with respect to the delay and will advise the Commission if any party interposes an objection.

I find that ODOE has provided good cause for granting the motion.

**RULING**

The Motion to Accept Late-Filed Comments of the Oregon Department of Energy is granted, subject to the condition that no other party interposes an objection on or before November 21, 2017.
