RULING

DISPOSITION: PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE SUSPENDED

On December 5, 2013, Columbia Basin Electric Cooperative, Inc. (Columbia Basin) filed a motion to suspend the procedural schedule in the above-captioned docket. In support of the motion, Columbia Basin states that it has reached a tentative agreement with Pacific Power and North Hurlburt Wind, LLC, on the framework for settlement. Columbia Basin explains that any proposed settlement will require a separate agreement with Columbia Basin's power supplier, Bonneville Power Administration. Columbia Basin believes it will reach an agreement with Bonneville Power Administration, but achieving that agreement will take additional time.

As no party objects to staying the procedural schedule in this proceeding, Columbia Basin's motion is granted. The procedural schedule is suspended indefinitely until Columbia Basin asks that a new procedural schedule be implemented.
