DISPOSITION: MOTION TO ADMIT PRO HAC VICE GRANTED

On September 10, 2014, Sierra Club filed a motion to allow Gloria D. Smith to appear as counsel *pro hac vice* in this proceeding. Ms. Smith states that she will associate with Kevin E. Parks, an active member in good standing with the Oregon State Bar. Sierra Club subsequently amended the motion with an executed acknowledgement of receipt from the Oregon State Bar concerning her certificate of compliance for *pro hac vice* admission.

I have reviewed the motion for admission *pro hac vice* and find that it complies with the requirements of UTCR 3.170 and OAR 860-001-0320. No objections have been received.

The motion to admit Gloria D. Smith as counsel *pro hac vice* on behalf of Sierra Club is granted for a one-year period. For cases continuing over one year, an attorney appearing *pro hac vice* must file a new application to continue to participate in the case.¹
