
Regarding violation of Protective Order

MEMORANDUM

The purpose of this memorandum is twofold. First, the Commission has agreed to hear oral arguments in this matter. Sierra Club made the request, which was not opposed by PacifiCorp, as part of its September 5, 2015, Reply Brief Denying Alleged Violations of Protective Order. Notice of the date and time for the oral argument will be issued separately.
