RULING

DISPOSITION: MOTION GRANTED; SCHEDULE AMENDED

On February 19, 2015, PacifiCorp, dba Pacific Power, filed an unopposed motion to amend the procedural schedule. In support of the motion, PacifiCorp asserts all parties agreed to the proposed changes during the parties' February 12, 2015 settlement conference. The parties also agreed to a five-business-day response time for data requests submitted on or after March 19, 2015. No other changes to the remainder of the procedural schedule are being requested at this time.


Accordingly, I find that Pacific Power has shown good cause for granting the motion and that no parties to the proceeding shall be adversely affected by the change to the procedural schedule.
