RULING

DISPOSITION: MOTION TO ADMIT *PRO HAC VICE* GRANTED


On January 26, 2015, Sierra Club filed a motion to admit Gloria Smith and Travis Ritchie to appear *pro hac vice* in this proceeding. Sierra Club states that the attorneys will associate with Joshua Smith, an active member in good standing with the Oregon State Bar.

I have reviewed the motion for admission *pro hac vice* and find that it complies with the requirements of UTCR 3.170 and OAR 860-001-0320. The period for any party to oppose a *pro hac vice* motion is 7 days after service. See OAR-860-001-0420(5).

The motion to admit Gloria Smith and Travis Ritchie as counsel *pro hac vice* on behalf of Sierra Club is granted subject to the condition that no party opposes the motion on or before February 2, 2015.

Parties are reminded that, for cases continuing over one year, an attorney appearing *pro hac vice* must file a new application to continue to participate in the case.
