Investigation to Explore Issues Related to a Renewable Generator's Contribution to Capacity. MEMORANDUM AND NOTICE OF PREHEARING CONFERENCE

In Order No. 15-077, the Commission opened this docket to explore issues related to a renewable generator's contribution to capacity. Last week, three independent experts provided background information to the Commissioners on certain methodologies to determine contribution to capacity.

As a next step in this investigation, the Commission wants to hear from the parties on issues related to a renewable generator's contribution to capacity. In two rounds of simultaneous filings, the Commission requests all parties address, at a minimum, the following matters:

- 1. The preferred methodology to calculate a renewable generator's contribution to capacity; and
- 2. The pros and cons of:
  - a. Using an Effective Load Carrying Capability (ELCC) calculation;
  - b. Requiring an alternative or approximation method to be benchmarked against an ELCC calculation; and
  - c. Requiring the utilities to use the same calculation method.

Accordingly, notice is given that a prehearing conference will be held to adopt a procedural schedule. At the conference we will discuss whether the filings should be made as comments, or as testimony that will allow an opportunity for hearing.
