RULING

DISPOSITION: MOTION TO HOLD PROCEEDINGS IN ABEYANCE GRANTED

On June 27, 2016, Surprise Valley Electrification Corp. filed a motion requesting to hold the current procedural in abeyance and to suspend the procedural schedule. Surprise Valley states that the parties have reached an agreement in principal, and believe that suspension of the schedule is in their best interests so they may focus on finalizing a settlement. Surprise Valley states that PacifiCorp does not oppose motion.

I find that good cause exists to hold the proceedings in abeyance and to suspend the procedural schedule. Surprise Valley's motion is granted.
