The Commission has received petitions to intervene in this docket from Renewable Northwest and Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities (ICNU). In addition, the Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon filed its notice of intervention in compliance with ORS 774.180.

This proceeding is not a contested case proceeding under ORS 183.310(2).
